Day 1: Sunday, September 18 – Villeneuve-les-Avignon

- Arrival – We'll stay at a choice of hotels... a charming family-owned boutique hotel located in the center of the historic Provencal village of Villeneuve-les-Avignon, across the Rhône River from Avignon... or you may choose to stay in the village's five-star Relais & Chateaux luxury signature hotel with a Michelin star restaurant. The two hotels are a short distance from each other. They will be our Provence home for the next six nights. Once checked in, the balance of the day is at your leisure to meander through Villeneuve-les-Avignon on your own... take a short taxi ride or a local bus to explore Avignon... or relax in the hotel gardens.
- 6:00 PM – **Welcome Reception** – With Côtes du Rhône wines and hors d'oeuvres hosted by Scott Hamill and Paint Europe... an opportunity to meet other guests and review the week's activities.
- Dinner - On your own... or join a local cuisine group dinner at your own expense. Restaurant personally-selected by Tom Harter, Paint Europe president.

Day 2: Monday, September 19 – Avignon

- For Early Risers – *Optional* before breakfast group pleasure walk through Villeneuve-les-Avignon.
- Breakfast – At the hotel.
- Morning – Today we'll cross the Rhône River for a first day demonstration and morning painting session with Scott in **Avignon's Old Town** by beautiful **Rue des Teinturiers**... with its picturesque canal, waterwheels & bridges; narrow lanes & scenic plazas; historic buildings with tiled roofs & wooden shutters; small shops & outdoor cafes.
- Lunch – On your own... or join a group lunch at your own expense.
- Afternoon – Open afternoon for personal time, options include... afternoon painting... visit to **Les Halles Avignon**, Avignon's colorful & bustling in-door food market with over 40 stalls... take a guided tour (at own expense) of Avignon's **The Palais des Papes**, the papal residence and the seat of Western Christianity during the 14th century, one of the largest and most important medieval Gothic buildings in Europe, a UNESCO World Heritage Site... explore Avignon boutiques... or relax at an outdoor café or in the hotel garden.

- Late-Afternoon – Join Scott for an optional “golden hour” *plein air* painting session in Villeneuve-les-Avignon.
- Before Dinner – Cocktail hour Côtes du Rhône wine gathering in the hotel garden hosted by Paint Europe.
- Dinner – On your own... or join a local cuisine group dinner at your own expense.

Day 3: Tuesday, September 20 – Gordes & Abbaye Notre-Dame Sénanque

- For Early Risers – *Optional* before breakfast group pleasure walk through Villeneuve-les-Avignon.
- Breakfast – At the hotel.
- Morning – After breakfast we’ll board our private minibus and travel through Provence’s lovely **Luberon Valley** countryside, with landscapes composed of stone farmhouses and vineyards, arriving to the historic walled village of **Gordes** and to iconic **Abbaye Notre-Dame Sénanque** for a demonstration and morning painting session with Scott.
- Lunch – Picnic lunch hosted by Paint Europe.
- Afternoon – Open afternoon for personal free time back in Villeneuve-les-Avignon.
- Late-Afternoon – Join Scott for an optional “golden hour” *plein air* painting session in Villeneuve-les-Avignon.
- Before Dinner – Cocktail hour Côtes du Rhône wine gathering in the hotel garden hosted by Paint Europe.
- Dinner – On your own... or join a local cuisine group dinner at your own expense.

Day 4: Wednesday, September 21 – Day Trip to Saint-Remy de Provence

- For Early Risers – *Optional* before breakfast group pleasure walk through Villeneuve-les-Avignon.
- Breakfast – At the hotel.
- Morning – After breakfast we’ll board our private minibus for a 45-minute drive to the historic and picturesque village of **Saint-Remy de Provence** for a demonstration and morning painting session with Scott. Saint-Remy de Provence is where Vincent van Gogh painted nearly 150 paintings and where he was institutionalized as a patient at the Saint-Paul Asylum.
- Lunch – Picnic lunch hosted by Paint Europe.
- Afternoon – Visit to Provence’s **Carrieres des Lumieres** to see the special 2022 multi-media artist exhibit.
- Late-Afternoon – Personal free time back in Villeneuve-les-Avignon.
- 5:00 PM – **French Provincial Cooking Class...** Evening cooking class and dinner with a local celebrated chef hosted by Paint Europe.

Day 5: Thursday, September 22 – Villeneuve-les-Avignon

- For Early Risers – *Optional* before breakfast group pleasure walk through Villeneuve-les-Avignon.
- Breakfast – At the hotel.
- Early-Morning – *Optional* visit to Villeneuve-les-Avignon’s Thursday Outside Market – just a two minute walk from our hotel, experience one of Provence’s most colorful traditional outside French markets... interact with local vendors and residents.
- Morning – Today we stay in **Villeneuve-les-Avignon** for a demonstration and morning painting session with Scott at **Abbaye Saint Andre & Jardins**. We’ll paint in the abbey’s lush & colorful garden, with its vista and majestic views.
- Lunch – On your own... or join a group lunch at your own expense.
- Afternoon – Open afternoon for free personal time, options include... afternoon painting... visit to Avignon for touring or shopping... take an afternoon guided tour (at own expense) to **Pont du Gard**, the ancient Roman aqueduct built in first-century AD, a UNESCO World Heritage Site... take an afternoon

guided tour (at own expense) & experience a **Côtes du Rhône wine tasting session in Chateauneuf-du-Pape**, Côtes du Rhône wine region's premiere village... or relax in the hotel garden.

- Late-Afternoon – Join Scott for an optional “golden hour” *plein air* painting session in Villeneuve-les-Avignon.
- Before Dinner – Cocktail hour Côtes du Rhône wine gathering in the hotel garden hosted by Paint Europe.
- Dinner – On your own... or join a local cuisine group dinner at your own expense.

Day 6: Friday, September 23 – Day Trip to Luberon Valley

- For Early Risers – *Optional* before breakfast group pleasure walk through Villeneuve-les-Avignon.
- Breakfast – At the hotel.
- Morning – After breakfast we'll board our private minibus and head to the **Luberon Valley** for a demonstration and morning painting session with Scott in one of Provence's *Les Plus Beaux Villages de France* (France's Most Beautiful Villages) - i.e.: **Bonnieux, Ménerbes, Roussillon, Fontaine-de-Vauclaus, Isle-Sur-La-Sorgue, Pernes les Fontaines**
- Late Lunch – On your own... or join group lunch at your own expense.
- Afternoon – Return back to Villeneuve-les-Avignon... personal free time for afternoon painting or relaxing.
- **Farewell Dinner** – Gala celebration meal with French Provincial cuisine and Côtes du Rhône wines hosted by Paint Europe.

Day 7: Saturday, September 24 – Villeneuve-les-Avignon

- For Early Risers – *Optional* before breakfast group pleasure walk through Villeneuve-les-Avignon.
- Breakfast – At the hotel.
- **Review Session** – Share paintings and group discussion led by Scott.
- Late-Morning – *Optional* visit to Villeneuve-les-Avignon's outside open Provence antiques market.
- Say Our Goodbyes – Departure home or to onward destinations.
